OFFICE MEMORANDUM.

Sub: Tarapur Atomic Power Station-School facilities
at the Station -Upgradation of the existing School
run by the Station to Higher Secondary Status on
the pattern of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangthan Schools.

The President is pleased to convey the approval for upgradation of the existing school run by the Tarapur Atomic Power Station to Higher Secondary Status on the pattern of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangthan (Central Schools Organization) effective from the academic session of 1971-72. The School will be run by the Atomic Energy Education Society, Bombay who have agreed to take over with effect from April 1, 1971. The standard of education, the medium of instructions, scale of furniture, equipment, etc will be according to the standards prescribed by KVS for the Schools run by Sangthan.

2) Standards VII and VIII will be added to the school from the academic year-1971-72 and thereafter one standard per year will be added till the full secondary status is attained.

3) The Society will employ teachers on the scales approved by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangthan from time to time. The number and qualifications of teachers employed, salaries, and allowances paid to them and all other conditions of service of the staff will be absolutely identical to those available to similar schools run under the aegis of the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangthan. The staff will be treated as employees of the Atomic Energy Education Society. The existing teachers of the Tarapur Atomic Power Station School will be employed by the Atomic Energy Education Society, if found suitable. The Decision of the Atomic Energy Education Society in this regard shall be final.

4) The school will charge fees from pupils on scales identical with those of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangthan Schools.

5) The Department of Atomic Energy will provide the school building, furniture and all other Capital Equipment necessary for running of the school. The Expenditure on the maintenance of these will also be borne by the Department of Atomic Energy.

6) Admission to the school will normally be restricted to the children of the employees of the Department of Atomic Energy and its constituent units. If vacancies exist in any standard after all eligible children of employees of the Department of Atomic Energy and its constituent units have been admitted, such vacancies may be filled by admitting children of other Central Government employees.

7) Kinder Garden classes do not form part of the schools run by KVS. In case, however, it is necessary to provide such classes, these may be opened as a part of the school but the running expenditure will be met entirely by the society from the fees recovered from the pupils or otherwise. In any other words, no grant or assistance will be made available for the purpose of meeting part or what-so-ever of the running expense of K.G. Classes.

8. The present facility of bus transport provided by the Tarapur Atomic Power Station to the Students attending English medium School at ~~Paigdar~~ will be withdrawn. The bus facility for the children who do not opt for the English medium school at Tarapur but opt ~~for~~ for the Marathi medium school at Chinchini will, however be continued as at present.

9. The Society will present to the Department every year a statement of expenditure and receipts in respect of this school. The Society will be entitled to assistance on the terms identical to those which as a school of the same size run directly under the auspices of the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan is entitled to. Sanction for the reimbursement of expenditure incurred by the Society to this extent will be issued by ~~the~~ this Department. It will be open to the Department to release to the Society funds for running of the school at periodic intervals in such ~~maner~~ manner as to ensure that the total releases during any particular period shall not exceed the amount the Society is entitled to on the basis stated above.

10. The expenditure on the running of the school will be apportioned amongst the various units concerned on the basis of the number of Children attending the school.
