**Sub: Advertisement for Engaging Teachers & LDC cum Typist on Contract Basis, in AEC  
Schools / Junior College, Tarapur for the Academic year 2026-27**

It is proposed to conduct a Skill test and Practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching class) for engaging teachers and a typing test followed by skill test for & LDC cum Typist purely on contract basis against the leave / regular vacancies that may arise during the Academic Year 2026-27. The details of post, pay, eligibility criteria and minimum and maximum age limits are given below.

**I. Educational and other qualification for the post of Post Graduate Teacher (PGT)**

1. Master's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms) in the respective subject (refer Table-1). The candidate should have studied the concerned subject in Graduation also.

OR

Integrated Post Graduate Course of Regional Institute of Education of NCERT or any other recognized institute in the respective subject ,(refer Table-1) with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's / institution's norms).

OR

Post Graduate degree in the respective subject, (refer Table-1) with at least 50% marks in aggregate or its equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms) from a recognized university and B.A.Ed. /B.Sc.Ed. from a recognized institute.

2. (a) B.Ed. or equivalent degree from recognized University/Institute.  
(b) B.Ed. is not required for the candidates with B.Sc.Ed or B.A.Ed. or M.Sc. Ed.
3. Proficiency in teaching in English medium (except for TGT(Hindi / Sanskrit).

**Note:** Candidates without B.Ed. can also apply, if they have secured 55% and above marks (for Commerce Subjects) in the Post-Graduation degree.

## II. Educational and other qualification for the Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) Post

1. Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms) in the respective subject(s) / combination of respective subjects.(Refer Table-2)

OR

Four years integrated degree course – B.A.Ed. or B.Sc.Ed. from Regional College of Education of NCERT/ from any National Council for Teacher Education recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's /institution's norms) in the respective subject(s) combination of respective subjects.

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2. (a) B.Ed. or equivalent degree from any recognized University /Institute.  
(b)B.Ed. is not required for the candidates with B.Sc.Ed or B.A.Ed. or M.Sc. Ed.
3. Qualified in Paper-II of Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by the CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
4. Proficiency in teaching in English medium {except for TGT (Hindi/Sanskrit) and TGT (Marathi)}.

**Note:** Candidates without B.Ed. and without CTET can also apply if they have secured 60% and above marks (for Science Subjects) and 55% and above marks (for Humanities Subjects) in the Graduation level.

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**IV Candidates without teaching qualification (B.Ed., D.El.Ed, B.EL.Ed, CTET) can also apply and will be empanelled separately on selection.**

**V Mode of Selection (For Contract Teachers)**

1. (a) A skill test and Practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching Class) will be conducted and the selected candidates will be empanelled and recruited in the order of merit.  
(b) Performance of the candidates will be assessed based on presentation by the candidates **on two topics, one chosen by self and other provided by the school** followed by personnel interaction on the subject.
2. 3 panels will be prepared:
  - a. Panel I – Candidates with all the requisite qualifications for PGTs, TGTs, PRTs and Balvatika teachers separately
  - b. Panel II – Candidates without CTET score for TGTs and PRTs separately
  - c. Panel III – Candidates without teaching qualification for PGTs, TGTs, PRTs and Balvatika teachers separately
3. The panels mentioned above will be operated in sequential order viz. in the order of their merit.
4. The panel is valid till 31<sup>st</sup> March 2027.
5. If the performance of the Contract teacher, any time during the period of contract, is not found as per the required standards, the contract can be terminated.
6. Contract teachers have to follow Conduct Rules prescribed by AEES during the service. Violation of Conduct of Rules can lead to termination of contract.
7. Service conditions will be applicable as per AEES norms.
8. The Reporting time for all the candidates is between 8:00 am to 12 Noon on respective dates of Skill Test. No candidate will be entertained beyond reporting hours.
9. If the number of candidates registered for the Skill Test is more, the number of days for the skill test will be extended accordingly. This information will be displayed on the noticeboards at the respective centre.
